- One went back to answer the telephone.
- One had a child that dawdled and did not get ready as soon as he should have.
- One could not get a taxi.

There were other stories that may be gathered now in a book. The one that struck me was the man who put on a new pair of shoes that morning, took the various means to get to work, but before he got there, he developed a blister on his foot. He stopped at a drugstore to buy a Band-Aid. That is why he is alive today.

Now when I am stuck in traffic, miss an elevator, turn back to answer a ringing phone, I think to myself, "I am exactly where I am supposed to be."

You are where you are supposed to be. Right here, right now. Don't take a day for granted.
