Happy May to one and all! I believe the snow has now passed and we should be ready to dive into springs' activities.

Here are some "Tips for a Lifetime"!

Use a meat baster to squeeze your batter onto the hot griddle. Perfect shaped pancakes every time.

To keep potatoes from budding, place an apple in the bag with the spuds.

To prevent eggshells from cracking, add a pinch of salt to the water before hard-boiling.

When boiling corn on the cob, add a pinch of sugar to help bring out the corn's natural sweetness.

To determine if an egg is still fresh, immerse it in a pan of cool, salted water. If it sinks...it is fresh. If it rises to the surface...throw it away.

Cure for a headache-Take a lime, cut it in half and rub it on your forehead. The throbbing will go away.

Potatoes will take food stains off your fingers. Just slice and rub!

UPDATE ON ENTRY TO CANADA!

The Canadian government announced that fully vaccinated travelers would no longer need to provide a negative coronavirus test before entering the country as of April 1, 2022.

Officials said fully vaccinated travelers may still need to take a COVID-19 molecular test on arrival on a random basis.
