RHRUBARB MUFFINS

MUFFINS: TOPPING:

1 1/4 cup brown sugar 1 egg 1/3 cup sugar 1 tsp cinnamon

1/2 cup veggie oil

1 cup buttermilk

1 tsp baking soda 1 1/2 cup rhubarb

2 1/2 cup flour

1/2 cup chopped walnuts (optional)

Mix muffin ingredients together, split into paper lined muffin tin. Mix together topping ingredients and spread 1 tsp onto each muffin before baking. Bake at 375 degrees for 15-20 minutes. Makes 24 muffins.

Crissy's Corner



- The Declaration of Independence was not signed on July 4, 1776. That is actually the day it was formally adopted by Continental Congress, but it wasn't signed by most signatories until August.
- Three presidents have died on July 4: Thomas Jefferson, John Adams, and James Monroe.
- Massachusetts became the first state to make the 4th of July an official state holiday in 1781.
- The famed Macy's fireworks show in New York City uses more than 75,000 fireworks shells and costs about \$6 million.
- Independence Day became a federal holiday in 1870.
- In 1778, George Washington gave his soldiers a double ration of rum to celebrate the July 4th holdiay.
- Every July 4th, descendants of the signers of the Declaration of Independence tap the Liberty Bell 13 times in honor of the original 13 Colonies.
- President Calvin Coolidge was born on July 4th, 1872.
