WEST VIRGINIA RAILS & WILLIAMSBURG

May 28th - June 4th, 2026

All aboard for 8 days and 7 nights of American history and fun. We kick off this journey with a Washington D.C. We start our West Coast adventure in Seattle visiting iconic places such as the Space Needle and Pike Place Market. We will tour Portland City and travel through the Willamette Valley before we visit Newport, founded in 1866.
