CRISSY'S CORNER

In honor of our recent trip to Cape Cod and the Islands... Enjoy!

NEW ENGLAND CLAM CHOWDER

5 lbs. small clams

1 lb. baby new potatoes (1" dice)

3 cups heavy cream

2 cups whole milk

6 shallots, thinly sliced

1 lemon, juice only

1 1/2 tbsp. parlsey, chopped

1 1/2 tbsp. dill, chopped

3 tbsp. olive oil

Pick through clams and discard any with cracked shells. In a large, lidded pot, heat clams and 1 1/2 cups water over high heat. Once water comes to a simmer, cover with lid and steam until clams just pop open (about four minutes). Remove pan from heat, shuck clams and discard shells. Discard any clams that don't open. Set clam meat aside. Discard any drippings and wipe pot clean.

Add potatoes, cream, milk and a pinch of salt and bring to a simmer over mediumhigh heat. Reduce heat to medium and simmer until potatoes are fork-tender (about 10 minutes). Meanwhile, in a small saucepan, heat olive oil over medium heat. Once hot, add shallots and cook, stirring frequently, until lightly caramelized (about seven minutes). Stir shallots into potato-cream mizture and simmer until flavors meld (two minutes). Add reserved clams. Season with salt, pepper and lemon juice to taste, and simmer until clams are just warmed through (about one minute). Remove soup from heat. Stir in parsley and dill. Serve immediately.
