Are you **REAL ID** ready? On **May 7th, 2025**, U.S. travelers must be REAL ID compliant to board domestic flights and access certain federal facilities.

WEST VIRGINIA RAILS & WILLIAMSBURG

May 28th - June 4th, 2026

All aboard for 8 days and 7 nights of American history and fun. We kick off this journey with a Washington D.C. Twilight Illumination Tour, then we are off on two rail adventures with the Potomac Scenic Eagle Rail and the New Tygart Flyer Train. Don't miss out on spending the night at the historic Greenbrier Resort & Bunker, where we will tour the now-declassified bunker built under the hotel in 1958. Day 5 takes us to Thomas Jefferson's Monticello. Journey to Jamestown and Yorktown where we continue to soak up the history that built this country. Day 7 will be spent visiting Colonial Williamsburg, a 173-acre living history museum. This immersive and authentic experience will transport you to the 18th century.

PACIFIC COAST ADVENTURE

August 9th - 16th, 2026

We start our West Coast adventure in Seattle visiting iconic places such as the Space Needle and Pike Place Market. We will tour Portland City and travel through the Willamette Valley before we visit Newport, founded in 1866. Day 5 is an adventure
