CRISSY'S CORNER

CANDIED CRANBERRIES

12 oz. Sprite 12 oz. cranberries, fresh 12 oz. juice of choice (I prefer Cran-Strawberry) 4 cups powdered sugar



- Step 2. Wash cranberries with water and drain.
- Step 3. Place cranberries in a large bowl and cover with Sprite and juice.
- Step 4. Cover and refrigerate for 8-12 hours, or overnight.
- Step 5. Drain cranberries from liquid and pour into clean bowl.
- Step 6. Coat with powdered sugar. It's easiest to shake it covered in a bowl with a lid.
- Step 7. Put berries on baking sheet and put in 200° oven for 5 minutes.
- Step 8. Enjoy and keep in an airtight container in the refrigerator.
