- St. Patrick was born in Britain, not Ireland.
- The color originally associated with St. Patrick was "St. Patrick's Blue," not green.
- The first St. Patrick's Day parade was held in St. Augustine, Florida, in 1601.
- It was once observed as a strict religious "dry" holiday in Ireland.
- Traditional Irish meals include Irish stew or bacon and cabbage — not corned beef.
- The Chicago River is dyed green annually by the Plumbers Local 110 union.
- The oldest continuous St. Patrick's Day Parade began in New York City on March 17, 1762.
